How to understand HIJAP?

When we were living at KL, we realized that we are facing some obstacles to understand malay culture. So we have been studying Malaysian culture by ourselves for 10 days. After daily meeting we share the time for Malaysian culture study. Each members prepared for the certain subject that he is interested. We shared our thoughts about the topics after the presentation.

For the next five weeks we will serialize our studies and today I want to introduce to one of the subjects, HIJAB.

According to the presentation, A Hijab that a scarf wore by Muslim women has long history. In the Koran say, women who wears a Hijab are desirable the Mohammed of wives. Muslim women think that Hijab covered with the head and the chest prevents temptation, and also they believe that Hijab can keep their purity. Muslim women know that Hijab has acted one of the restraints on.

Nowadays due to effect of feminism, the wearing of Hijab isn't duty. But when we saw the Muslim woman wearing a Hijab, we thought they are lunatic. Because we saw repeatedly reports from Saudi Arabia has the worst human right within the western broadcasting.

It is hard to judge whether wearing a Hijab encroach on woman's rights or not. To understand this dispute, we have to know the controversy of Islam. Some scholars insist that Islam extends the women's rights. Before birthing Islam, the Islam's birthplace people feel shameful when they were born girl, so the most of people buried babies alive. But after birthing Islam this custom disappeared and people's thoughts have

changed. After that Muslim thinks that man has rights for his wife and also woman has rights for their husband.

The other scholars claim that Islam forced wear Hijab and It is an infringement of women's rights. Besides that, Muslim accepts polygamy and that means Muslim treated women as an object. According to this insistence, France banned people from putting on Hijab at public place.

Muslim women resisted this regulation and they said it is one of racial discrimination. From that occasion, some people wearing Hijab as a means to defiance. Nowadays Hijab are used as fashion item such as perfect gem brand like Prada sells various Hijap.
